Stall Holder Agreement

Chariot Festival – 09 August 2026 in Deans Garden

The purpose of this agreement is to ensure that the Chariot Festival is operated in a safe, organised, clean and enjoyable manner for all visitors, traders and organisers.

By signing this agreement, the Stall Holder agrees to comply with the following Terms & Conditions.

1. Event Details

Event: Chariot Festival

Date: Sunday, 09 August 2026

Location: Deans Gardens, London

2. Stall Allocation

Each approved trader will be allocated:

- 1 x 3m x 3m gazebo
- 1 x table
- 2 x chairs

Table coverings are not provided. Traders must bring their own coverings and any additional equipment required for trading.

The trader may only operate within the allocated stall space. No stock, tables, signage or equipment may extend beyond the allocated area without prior approval from the organisers.

3. Arrival & Set-Up

All traders must attend either the day before the event **between 10:00am and 6:00pm**, or on the event day **between 6:00am and 9:00am**, to complete their stall set-up and arrangements.

This includes:

- unloading stock
- setting up displays
- electrical setup (if applicable)
- arranging signage and decorations



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All stall set-up must be fully completed by **9:00am on the event day**.

Any trader unable to attend during the allocated set-up periods must notify the organisers in advance.

Any trader arriving after **9:00am on the event day** may be refused vehicle access and may be required to carry goods into the event area by foot.

4. Vehicle Access

Vehicles are permitted inside Deans Gardens for loading and unloading only.

Once unloading is complete:

- vehicles must be removed immediately from the site
- no trader vehicles may remain parked inside Deans Gardens during the event

Hazard lights must be used when entering the site and all drivers must take extra care due to staff, volunteers and members of the public being present.

There is no parking available on site unless otherwise agreed by the organisers.

5. Trading Hours & Pack Down - As Per Ealing Council Regulations

Trading must cease at 5:00pm on the event day.

All traders must:

- stop serving customers by 5:00pm
- begin pack down promptly after trading ends
- remove all stock, equipment and materials from the site
- fully vacate the stall area by 6:00pm

Vehicles must not enter the event area for collection until permission is given by event organisers for public safety reasons.

6. Waste Disposal & Cleaning

All traders are fully responsible for keeping their stall area clean throughout the event.

Traders must:

- bring sufficient rubbish bags
- collect all waste generated from their stall



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- remove all rubbish, cardboard boxes, packaging and food waste from the site
- leave the allocated stall space clean and tidy before departure

No rubbish may be left on the ground, around the stall, or in Deans Gardens.

7. Penalty for Non-Compliance

Failure to comply with any of the following may result in a £300 penalty charge:

- failure to arrive during the allocated setup period
- failure to complete setup within the agreed time
- continuing to trade after 6:00pm on the event day
- failure to clear the stall and vacate the site by 8:00pm
- leaving rubbish, waste, packaging or materials behind
- failure to leave the stall area clean and tidy

The organisers reserve the right to deduct this amount from any deposit held or issue an invoice payable by the trader.

8. Sale of Goods

The trader agrees to sell only the goods listed on their application form.

No additional goods may be sold without prior written approval from the Temple organisers.

Any unapproved goods may result in immediate closure of the stall without refund.

Food traders must ensure all food is stored safely and kept off the floor where possible.

All products sold must comply with UK Trading Standards and food hygiene regulations.

9. Health & Safety

All traders agree to:

- keep their stall safe, clean and hazard-free at all times
- appoint sufficient staff to safely manage the stall
- comply with all instructions from Temple representatives, event organisers, stewards and Ealing Council officers



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- ensure any electrical appliances used have valid safety testing certification where required
- take reasonable precautions to avoid damage to the event site

Temple representatives and Council officers reserve the right to suspend or close any stall that presents a health and safety risk.

10. Prohibited Activities

The following are strictly prohibited unless prior written approval has been granted:

- public address systems
- amplified music
- product advertising unrelated to the trader's stall
- smoking while operating a stall
- being under the influence of alcohol or drugs
- sale of helium balloons

Any unacceptable behaviour, verbal abuse, physical aggression or anti-social conduct towards customers, staff, volunteers or other traders may result in immediate removal from the event.

11. Complaints & Liability

Any complaints received regarding a trader's products, services or conduct will be referred directly to the Stall Holder and remain their responsibility to resolve.

The Temple accepts no responsibility for:

- loss or theft of stock
- damage to trader equipment
- disputes relating to goods sold by traders

Each trader remains responsible for their own public liability and insurance requirements where applicable.



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12. Acceptance
